A Professional Development Opportunity for 9-12 Educators

Free, Self-Paced Online Workshop

In Summer 2021, UNH Manchester will offer a free, online professional development opportunity for high school English Language Arts educators, English Learner (EL) teachers, and school library media specialists. The aim of the workshop is to collaborate on teaching strategies for preparing first-generation and EL students to successfully transition to college. The workshop modules will discuss the rhetorical contexts of college writing.

Topics include:

- Teaching strategies related to college-level reading expectations
- College composition curricula and practices
- Writing in the disciplines
- Information literacy and academic research
- Supporting English learners in the classroom
